- 1) Apologies from Len Ware. Sympathy Card to be sent by ENN. Peter had hoped that David Walker might be able to attend to give guidance n generating a Heritage Centre. However, this is no longer his remit and Liz Neathey is the Development Officer for what was Somerset County Museum.
- 1) Matters arising not covered in the agenda: CJN to overcome the clash of the AGM being held at the Salvation Army on the same night that the Carnival Committee are still using it. Len Ware's book raised discussion with Len allowing Amanda to re-write the Convent section. Chris to have another chat with Len. It is better for the book to be published as accurate as possible. The Committee did not overturn its previous decision (30th March) not to be at the Shepton Show in August, but Alan Stone hoped that at least we might have an 8 by 4 board of Post Office display. The archivist was not happy to provide anything as it is not Committee policy to be at the Show.
